


NIHR brand guidelines for ARC EM researchers



This document provides guidance on how to brand study outputs funded or supported by the NIHR. An output is any item arising from the NIHR-funded research that enters the public domain. Outputs can be written, audio/visual, electronic or verbally presented.

NOTIFICATION/BRANDING REQUIREMENTS

All NIHR-funded researchers are required to:

- Publish the main study findings in a peer-reviewed, open access journal
- Notify the NIHR and provide final copies of any outputs from their research ahead of them appearing in the public
 domain. Providing at least at least 28 days' advance notification is a contractual obligation of your research contract
 with the CCF Infrastructure Team (email: ccf-infrastructure-team@nihr.ac.uk)
- Send press releases to ccfcomms@nihr.ac.uk in advance
- Acknowledge the NIHR funding on all outputs, and where appropriate, display the 'Funded by NIHR' logo alongside

ACKNOWLEDGING THE NIHR

All written and oral outputs must acknowledge NIHR ARC EM as the funder and, when mentioning research findings or opinions, use the NIHR disclaimer:

This study/project is funded by/supported by the National Institute for Health Research (NIHR) Applied Research Collaboration East Midlands (ARC EM). The views expressed in this publication are those of the author(s) and not necessarily those of the National Institute for Health Research or the Department of Health and Social Care.

BRANDING

The NIHR want you to use the 'Funded by NIHR' logo on visual and digital outputs, such as research posters, research slides and websites.



It should be positioned along with an acknowledgment and a disclaimer as follows:

- On websites above the fold but not in the header i.e. so that it is visible without scrolling down the page
- In print, such as on your institution's templates for research posters and patient leaflets, below the fold/in the bottom half of the page
- In research slides, use the 'Funded by NIHR' logo on the first slide and the appropriate acknowledgement and disclaimer on the final slide.

Should your research study have its own logo, this can also be used on outputs, providing the NIHR acknowledgement is also in place.
