Ethnic inequalities in health and social care outcomes have been well documented in published research. This disparity is even more stark in the COVID-19 pandemic, where it has become clear that people from minority ethnic groups are disproportionately affected by coronavirus infection.

Yet minority ethnic populations are much less likely to be represented in research studies. The reasons for this are complex, with some of the barriers arising out of cultural differences, health literacy, language and accessibility, as well as stigma regarding some health conditions.

- Resources toolkits and training to increase Diverse participation in research
